PHMSA Activities

PHMSA Updates R&D Database to Reflect New Projects. The Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) recently updated its research and development database to reflect a variety of new research grants that have been awarded for pipeline safety-related research projects. The projects address pipeline construction quality; corrosion prevention, detection and repair; in-situ corrosion monitoring; advanced in-line inspection; and non-destructive, in the ditch testing of pipeline material properties. Updates are here.¹

Comments on Class Location Requirements. A reminder that comments are due on November 1 on PHMSA's notice concerning potential changes to the class location requirements for gas pipelines. PHMSA's notice is here, ² and the notice extending the comment period is here. ³

Status of PHMSA Rulemakings. The table below reflects publicly available information on the status of PHMSA rulemakings. Due to the recent federal government shutdown, DOT will not publish a significant rulemaking status report for October, and will resume publication with the November report. Select Activities from the States

County Commissioner Named to Oklahoma Pipeline Safety Task Force. Oklahoma Governor Mary Fallin has named County Commissioner Ray Vaughn to the state's Pipeline Safety Task Force. The Task Force is charged with ensuring Oklahoma complies with federal pipeline safety standards for damage prevention and enforcement. The executive order establishing the Task Force requires the panel issue its preliminary assessment of the state's compliance efforts and any recommendations by December 1, 2013.

Railroad Commission of Texas Updates Safety Program Fees. At an October 22 open meeting, the Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) adopted amendments to its regulations to increase the annual pipeline safety program fees for distribution pipeline operators. The RRC increased the annual per service line fee from 75 cents to one dollar in order to support the hiring of additional inspection and support staff, as authorized under recently enacted Texas Senate Bill 1 (2013). The amendments are here.⁷
