## **Pipeline Safety Update** Issue No. 65 – October 9, 2013

PHMSA curtails operations during partial government shut-down. PHMSA awards \$46 million in pipeline safety base grants. Office of the Federal Register issues proposed rules addressing incorporation by reference. Common Ground Alliance issues 2012 DIRT Report.

## PHMSA Curtails Operations During Partial Government Shut-Down

As a result of the lapse in appropriations for Federal government operations in fiscal year 2014, PHMSA has curtailed its operations. The Department of Transportation's contingency plan for operations during the funding lapse states that investigations and enforcement functions will continue. Other activities, such as legal services, regulatory analysis and planning, and training, are suspended. DOT's contingency plan is here.<sup>1</sup>

# **PHMSA Awards \$46 Million in Pipeline Safety Base Grants**

On September 30, PHMSA announced that it has awarded a total of \$46 million in base grants to 46 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico. These grants fund up to 80% of the program costs in states with certified safety programs for intrastate pipelines. PHMSA's press release announcing the awards is here.<sup>2</sup>

## Office of Federal Register Issues Proposed Rules Addressing Incorporation by Reference

On October 2, the Office of the Federal Register (OFR), issued a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (NPRM) proposing to require that agencies seeking the OFR Director's approval to incorporate materials by reference into their regulations describe in the preamble the steps taken to either make the incorporated material "reasonably available" to interested parties or to summarize the contents of the materials the agency wishes to incorporate. The NPRM references the Pipeline Safety Act requirement that prohibits PHMSA from

# **Industry Updates**

Common Ground Alliance issues 2012 DIRT Report. On September 10, the Common Ground Alliance (CGA) issued its 2012 Damage Information Reporting Tool (DIRT) Report, which provides a summary analysis of underground facility damage events during 2012. CGA states that the DIRT Report shows that when a locate request precedes an excavation, damage is avoided 99% of the time. The DIRT report also notes that the total number of events was higher in in 2012, but attributes the increase to an higher level of
