Professional Background

Mike Farber has twenty years of experience, both as a partner in private practice and as a government official, in rapidly assessing, investigating, and resolving compliance issues across a wide variety of industries. During his tenure at BSEE, spanning the initial five years of the agency's existence, Mike led or was involved in all significant BSEE enforcement and investigative matters.

Mike leads internal investigations, provides strategic advice, and conducts compliance reviews for companies in energy and other sectors. Drawing upon his experience both in private practice and at the U.S. Department of Justice, Mike also represents clients in federal and state antitrust investigations, complex litigation, and intricate compliance matters.
